Interpretation Guide

Photo Identification Requirements for Registration

Last revised April 2023

The *Pharmacy Regulations, 2014* state that applicants for registration must provide “*photo identification acceptable to the board.*” For the purposes of this section, acceptable photo identification must meet the requirements defined below.

1) Identification must:

- a) be valid and current;
- b) have been issued by a federal, provincial, or territorial government, or, in the case of international applicants, by a foreign government; and
- c) include a clear photo of the applicant, along with their legal name and date of birth.

2) Acceptable forms of identification for registration include:

- a) Passport;
- b) Provincial or territorial driver’s license; or
- c) Provincial or territorial photo identification card.

Other forms of identification may be acceptable if they meet all of the conditions specified in section 1).
